As you read the stories you sometimes have the feeling that you are looking in a mirror.

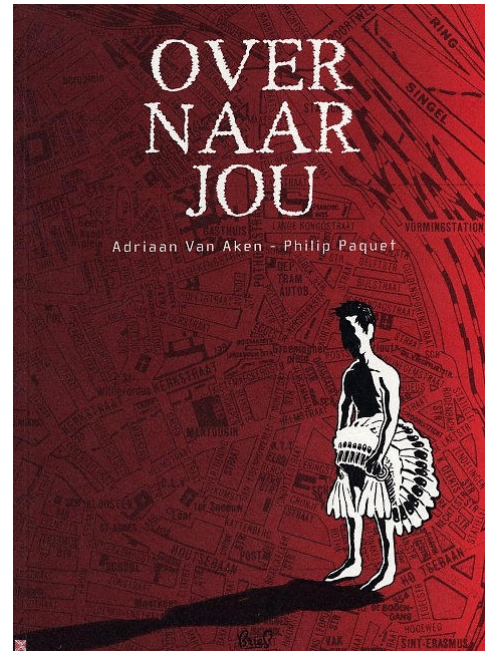

'Over to You' is the product of a special collaboration between theatre-maker and multi-media artist Adriaan van Aken, musician Youri van Uffelen and comic book artist Philip Paquet. The result is 'a comic book with a soundtrack': a script that was originally written as a theatrical text was translated by Philip Paquet into a very personal graphic idiom, and a soundtrack was added. This publication was later followed by 'Over to you once more', based on the same successful formula.

'Over to You' is a graphic novel that reacts to the here and now and is set in our modern multicultural society with all its pros and cons. The strip is also inextricably linked with Antwerp, the city where the cartoonist and the scriptwriter have lived all their lives.

Philip Paquet (b. 1973) is a Flemish illustrator and comic book artist. He published his first book in 1998. Many others followed, including no less than four albums on his favourite musical genre: jazz. 'Louis Armstrong' and 'Jelly Roll Morton', two graphic novels on the eponymous jazz legends, particularly stand out. Paquet is one of the most multi-disciplinarian comic book authors in Flanders. **Adriaan van Aken** (b. 1973) is a Flemish theatre-maker and multi-media artist. After his drama training at the RITCS he joined the infant Braakland/Zhebuilding, where together with his fellow-student Stijn Devillé he developed a unique form of musical theatre. 2006 saw the appearance of the strip-with-soundtrack 'Over to You', on which he collaborated with the musician Youri van Uffelen and cartoonist Philip Paquet.
